Registration:

Daily, 9.00am / 10.00am & 1.15pm / 2.00pm.

PI Insurance:

Proof of Personal Indemnity Insurance must be shown at registration or a £5 charge will be payable. Students from outside of the UK must provide proof of insurance taken out to cover them for Summer School.
